

# **FIRE ACTION**

#### INTRODUCTION

All staff, visitors and contractors should read these instructions and make themselves familiar with the means of escape from this building.

### **ACTION ON DISCOVERING A FIRE**

- 1. Raise the alarm by breaking the nearest **BREAK GLASS UNIT**
- 2. Evacuate the building quickly and calmly by the <u>nearest available safe exit</u> and go to the assembly point.
- 3. Give any relevant information to the person taking the roll call.
- 4. **Do not** re-enter the building until informed that it is safe to do so by the Fire & Rescue Service.

## **ACTION ON HEARING THE FIRE ALARM**

# (The fire alarm is a continuous Siren)

- 1. Switch off all electrical appliances before leaving the building, where possible.
- 2. Leave the area using the **nearest available safe exit**
- 3. **Do not** stop to collect coats or other personal belongings.
- 4. If possible, close all doors and windows behind you.
- 5. Proceed directly to the designated assembly point.
- 6. If you have any visitors on the premises, you must lead them to the **Assembly Point** and inform the person taking the roll call.

#### THE ASSEMBLY POINT is:

The grassed area on the other side of the road adjacent to the Post Office
